Abies Concolor	White Fir - Zone 4	Beautiful large tree with smooth gray bark. Needles are vivid blue-green. Up to 50 ft.
Abies Concolor Blue Cloak	White Fir - Zone 4	Graceful evergreen grows in a prostrate mounding form. 5 ft x 3 ft at maturity
Abies Concolor Compacta	Dwarf White Fir - Zone 4	Slow growing irregular form with bright blue-silver needles. 6x6 ft.
Abies Fraseri	Fraser Fir - Zone 4	Fast growing. Up to 60 ft. at maturity. Grows best in moist, well-drained soil.
Abies Horstman's	Silberlocke Fir - Zone 5	Unusual evergreen with bright silver undersides on the foliage. To 20 ft.
Abies Koreana Aurea	Dwarf Compact Golden Koren Fir	Slowing growing evergreen with yellow shading in spring. 20 ft. x 12 ft.
Abies Lasiocarpa Arizona Compacta	Dwarf Alpine Fir - Zone 5	Slow growing fir forming a conical to oval tree with blue-gray foliage. 10 ft x 15 ft
Abies Pinsapo Glauca	Spanish Fir - Zone 6	Short rigid form with striking blue needles. To 15 ft.
Abies Procera la Graciosa	La Graciosa Noble Fir - Zone 5	Slow growing fir with irregular mounding habit. Powder blue foliage, grows to 3 ft. x 5 ft.
Acer Freemani Autumn Blaze	Autumn Blaze Maple - Zone 4	Dense rounded head with red color in fall. 50 ft

Acer Japonica Meigetsu	Meigetsu Japanese Maple - Zone 5	Large bright green leaves turn to fall colors of gold and red. A sturdy, multi-branched tree. Grows to 25 ft
Acer Japonica Oisami	Oisami Japanese Maple - Zone 5	Large rich green leaves turn to an outstanding combination of reds, yellows and scarlet in the fall. Up to 20 ft
Acer Japonicum Green Cascade	Weeping Full Moon Maple - Zone 5	Emerald green leaves turn a shocking array of autumn colors. 6 ft x 8 ft
Acer Joe Witt	Manchurian Snakebark Maple - Zone 5	The striped silvery bark is otherworldly. 25 ft. x 25 ft.
Acer Palmatum Arakawa	Cork Bark Maple - Zone 5	Green leafed shrubby tree produces corky bark and yellow to scarlet fall foliage. 20 ft
Acer Palmatum Asahi Zuru	Rising Sun Jap Maple - Zone 5	Sharply defined clear variegations highlight this small tree. 10-12 ft
Acer Palmatum Atrolineare	Lineariflobum Japanese Maple - Zone 5	Brick red foliage blends with green undersides and almost black veins. Quite unique and rare. Small tree or large shrub. 15 ft x 8 ft

Acer Palmatum Diss. Filigree Purpureum	Purple Fil. Dwarf Laceleaf Maple -Zone 5	Purple foliage that is very heavily dissected and lacey makes this small tree stand out from the rest. 6 ft x 8 ft

Acer Palmatum Dissectum Red Select	Laceleaf Japanese Maple - Zone 5	Mound shaped deciduous shrub. Brilliant reddish purple finely divided foliage in spring and summer fade to rich crimson in fall. 8-12 ft x 8-12 ft.

Acer Palmatum Okagami	The Mirror Jap Maple - Zone 5	Purplish-red foliage turns to shiny black-red. Fall colors of red and scarlet. 15 ft
Acer Palmatum Okushimo	Okushimo Japanese Maple - Zone 5	Dark green leaves with rolled edges and an upright vase shape. Fall colors of yellow and gold. 20 ft
